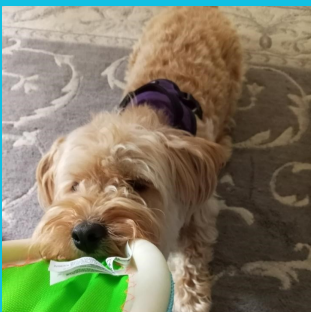
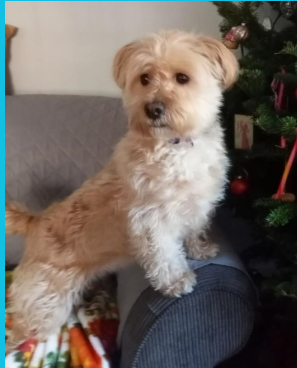
Meet Trixie!

Do You Know the 7-second Rule?

Dogs have sensitive paw pads that become vulnerable in the heat. Pavement, asphalt & artificial grass can become searingly hot causing blisters or burns on their paw pads. Hot pavement can also increase the overall body temperature of your pet & lead to heat stroke. If the outside temperature is a comfortable 77 degrees, driveways and roads can still **reach 125 degrees Fahrenheit**. At 87 degrees a **blazing 143 degrees** can be reached on the asphalt's surface. A good rule of thumb to follow is the 7-second rule: if you can press the back of your hand against the ground for 7 seconds, it's safe for your dog to walk upon. Keeping walks to natural grass in the morning or evening hours is typically a safer option for those adorable toe beans.

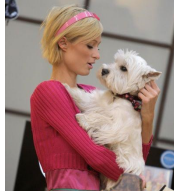

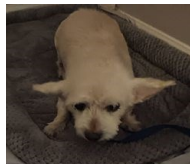
